

ORDINANCE NO. 194

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCES NO. 7 AND NO. 31, INCREASING AUTHORITY TO PURCHASE PERSONAL PROPERTY

The City of Luna Pier Ordains:

1. The Mayor or the Mayor's designee is authorized to contract on behalf of the City of Luna Pier for the purchase or sale of personal property in such manner as the Mayor shall deem to be in the City's best interest, provided, however, that the amount involved in the purchase or sale does not exceed the sum of \$20,000.00.
2. The Council is authorized to contract on behalf of the City of Luna Pier for the purchase and sale of personal property in such manner as the Council determines to be in the City's best interest, provide, however, that the amount involved does not exceed the sum of \$20,000.00.
3. In all cases that the purchase or sale of personal property exceeds the sum of \$20,000.00, the Council shall seek competitive sealed bids. The purchase shall be made from the lowest competitive bidder, unless the Council shall determine that the public interest will be best served by accepting a higher bid.
4. This Ordinance will take effect (10) days after publication.

This Ordinance was adopted at and recorded in the Minutes of the City Council meeting held on the 27th day of July, 2006, and was published in the Monroe Evening News on the 5th day of August, 2006.
