ORDINANCE NO. 245
EMERGENCY SERVICE FEES ORDINANCE

An Ordinance to establish setting fees for providing emergency services to non-residents.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LUNA PIER ORDAINS:

SECTION 1 - PURPOSE.

The within ordinance is to provide to levy charges and collect fees by the City of Luna Pier Police and/or City of Luna Pier Fire Department, rendered to protect individuals and the property of individuals who are not City of Luna Pier residents; to provide for notification of said fees by resolution; and to provide an effective date therefore.

Chargeable calls included in the ordinance for both Police and/or Fire Departments are:

- Accidents involving aircraft and/or rail trains
- Car fires (both accidental and arson)
- Marine/boat fires and rescues
- Non-injury vehicle accidents
- PDA accidents (property damage accident)
- PI accidents (personal injury)
- Recovery of stolen vehicles and properties
- Safety investigations
- Traffic obstructions caused by vehicles where Police provide traffic control.

SECTION 2 - ESTABLISHMENT OF FEES.

City of Luna Pier finds that any and all persons receiving emergency police and/or emergency fire protection services for the protection of their persons or property, who are not residents of City of Luna Pier at the time of said services are provided, shall remit the amount set forth in the Schedule of Fees attached hereto for each incident requiring services, with said funds to be used to defray the costs of operating and housing equipment, labor and supplies for such services by the City Police and Fire Departments.

SECTION 3 - FEES AND CHARGES

Fees and charges set forth in the Schedule of Fees attached hereto (Appendix A) may be modified from time to time by Resolution of the City Counsel of City of Luna Pier..

The Schedule of Fees shall be available at the Office of the City Clerk for inspection by the public during regular office hours.

SECTION 4 - BILLING

The expense of an emergency response shall be a charge imposed upon the responsible

party under this Ordinance. The charge constitutes a debt of that responsible party (s) and is collectible by the City in the same manner as an obligation under contract, express or implied.

SECTION 5 - MULTIPLE PROTECTION OR AID

When a particular service rendered by the City Police Department and/or Fire Department directly benefits more than one non-resident person or their property, the owner of each property so benefited, and each person so benefited, where property protection is not involved, shall be liable for the payment of the full charge for such service herein before outlined.

SECTION 6 - COLLECTIONS

The City of Luna Pier may proceed in district court by suit to collect any monies remaining unpaid after thirty (30) days of billing, and shall have any and all other remedies provided by law for the collection of said charges.

SECTION 7 - REPEAL

Any Ordinance, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 8 - EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption and a summary of it has been published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Luna Pier.

**PROCEDURE FOR BILLING ORDINANCE #245
EMERGENCY SERVICE FEES ORDINANCE**

Pertaining to a call that is defined by Ordinance #244:

1. (A) Complete **Form 245A** - City of Luna Pier Fire Department authorization to bill for fire/rescue service, **or**

(B) Complete **Form 245B** – City of Luna Pier Police Department authorization to bill for police service.

(C) Check if a corresponding billing from other Departments is applicable.
2. Keep one (1) copy for your department master file.
3. Submit invoice to the City Treasurer within fourteen (14) days of the incident or at the time the investigation is complete. (Submitting the invoice to the treasurer.)

The treasurer will then proceed with the billing and collection process.
